advance. Each prisoner received a package of sweets, and those who completed the course a special gift. A generous sponsor made it possible, God bless him for it. The most appreciated time was when we started worship the Lord singing together. We prayed also and preached the Word of God. Several inmates opened their hearts to the Lord and prayed with me. 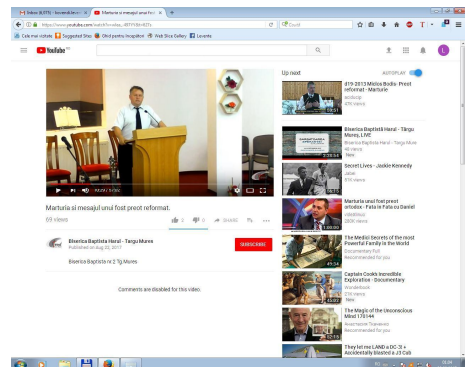
Here is the result of their work. The Lord blessed them, and many souls felt the touch of God.
