Viorel from Codlea wrote:

„Celebrating the end of the course on 7th May: We completed the course with the inmates' team, 9 out of 12 students completed the course and received credits. I invited young people from the local Church in Codlea to sing, and their pastor Dragu Angel preached the Gospel. With the graduated inmates we sang the song "Be my Light," this was the first time they sang in front of other invited inmates. Each one

received a package with sweets, and the group received a consistent gift from a generous sponsor. I also offered 5 Bibles. We prayed together and many of them opened their heart for Jesus and prayed with me.

Prison invitation for a special event on 25th May:

The prison leadership invited all those involved in re-entry to a working and informing meeting; people from probation, unemployment, school inspectorate, town hall, volunteers, organizations. I had the opportunity to say a few words about the work I am doing. I talked about the experience with Yi Feng and Tibor. I showed them the painting from Yi Feng, they all were amazed. It was a very good time, an opportunity for a testimony what the Lord is doing in the prison.”

The TgMures team also celebrated the final exam and they did outside prison by having a pizza in the town. Doczy and Attila and the group of happy inmates.



This month was more about communication with new prisons and meeting the legal requirements for last month recruited volunteers. By increasing the number of new prisons our efforts slowly became a nationwide ministry. We witnessed God's hand achieving this. We agree with Ken Helmuth that God will open doors in the future for the extending our work for surrounding countries as Hungaria and Moldavia. We speak fluent Hungarian and Romanian these countries spoken languages. We pray that the Lord rise new volunteers who would serve in these countries.



All the volunteers here in Romania are committed to serving on a weekly basis. Bible courses have always many attendees. At the end of the course, a test is given to be graded. The advantage of Romanian system is that these grades are considered by the court. This is the rewarding experience for the inmates. We know that their self-worth is restored when they receive recognition for their study efforts. We pray for life-changing results and for the inmates to mature in their faith.

We are preparing a three prison crusade for next week with a Hungarian evangelist named Boros Lajos (on the picture). Churches, schools, events with his testimony. This will be wonderful opportunity to serve the Lord Jesus Christ! Please pray for his safe travel and the Holy Spirit's presence on these events.
