John Haeffele and Ramon Portillo shared testimonies of lives changed while incarcerated.

The keynote speaker was Gracia Burnham. Gracia shared a powerful personal testimony of the capture of Gracia and Martin (her husband), their captivity for over a year, along with their rescue. Martin was killed during their rescue while Gracia was wounded. Gracia shared how the Lord turned her heart to love her capturers, and even though many of them received life sentences, a number of them have given their heart to Christ while in prison. Gracia was able to return to the Philippines to visit many people and encourage them in the Lord.

John Haeffele shared how Berean volunteers shared the truth of Christ's love with him while at the Tazewell county jail. John shared his thanksgiving for all that shared truth with him during and after his incarceration.

Ramon Portillo gave a testimony of his initial resistance to hearing the Word of God, but how a simple gift of a Bible with his name in it, meant so much. Ramon had never touched a Bible before, and he never had seen his name printed on anything good. He read the whole Bible many times. He could not believe the history and the forgiveness and healing that Jesus was offering him. Even though he spent 20 years in prison, his heart was changed by Christ in the county jail because of the volunteers that faithfully visited him and that stayed in touch with him over the years.
